The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 16-219, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **AMY MACHADO** of **FORT LEE**, who was admitted to appear <u>pro hac</u> <u>vice</u> in this State in 2011, should have her <u>pro hac vice</u> privileges suspended for violating <u>RPC</u> 3.3(a)(1)(lack of candor to a tribunal), <u>RPC</u> 5.5(a)(1)(unauthorized practice of law), <u>RPC</u> 8.4(c)(conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation), and <u>RPC</u> 8.4(d)(conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further concluded that the Office of Attorney Ethics should refer respondent's conduct to the disciplinary authorities in New York;

And the Court having determined from its review of the matter that respondent should be permanently barred from appearing <u>pro hac vice</u> in New Jersey for her unethical conduct;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that AMY MACHADO is permanently barred from

appearing pro hac vice in New Jersey; and it is further

ORDERED that the Office of Attorney Ethics shall refer respondent's conduct to the New York attorney disciplinary authorities; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
