Steven Daniel Freesman of Fort Lee, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1989, having tendered his consent to disbarment as an attorney at law of the State of New Jersey, and good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that Steven Daniel Freesman is disbarred by consent, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent's name be stricken from the roll of attorneys and that he be permanently restrained and enjoined from practicing law; and it is further

ORDERED that the Attorney-Trustee appointed pursuant to Rule 1:20-19 for the protection of the clients and preservation of the law practice of Steven Daniel Freesman shall make appropriate disbursements from respondent's accounts to those clients and others whose funds can be identified, and at the conclusion of the trusteeship, the funds remaining, if any, shall be transferred to the Superior Court Trust Fund, where they shall remain restrained from

disbursement pending the further Order of the Supreme Court; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with
disbarred attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part
of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight
Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in
the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
