The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 18-364, concluding that as a matter of reciprocal discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-14(a)(4)(E), **Robert Arthur Plagmann of Dolphin, Virginia**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2006, should be reprimanded based on discipline imposed by the United States Department of the Navy for unethical conduct that in New Jersey constitutes a violation of RPC 8.4(c)(conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit or misrepresentation);
