The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 19-115, concluding that **John Joseph Hutt** of **Margate**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1999, and who has been temporarily suspended from the practice of law since August 21, 2017, pursuant to the Order of this Court filed July 20, 2017, should be disciplined for violating RPC 1.1(a)(gross neglect), RPC 1.3(lack of diligence), RPC 1.4(b)(failure to communicate), RPC 1.16(d)(on termination of representation, failure to surrender papers and property to which client is entitled), and RPC 8.1(b)(failure to cooperate with disciplinary authorities);

And the Court having determined from its review of the matter that a censure is the appropriate quantum of discipline for respondent's unethical conduct;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that John Joseph Hutt is hereby censured; and it is

further

ORDERED that respondent shall remain suspended from the practice of law pursuant to the Order of this Court filed July 20, 2017, and pending his compliance with the determination of the District I Fee Arbitration determination in District Docket No. I-2016-0021F, and payment of sanction to the Disciplinary Oversight Committee, and until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
