(Attorney No. 003371997) :

It is ORDERED that **Joseph Peter Barrett**, formerly of **Salt Lake City, Utah**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1997, is suspended from the practice of law for a period of 150 days, effective March 24, 2017, and until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that **Joseph Peter Barrett** comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with suspended attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that pursuant to Rule 1:20-20 (c), respondent's failure to comply with the Affidavit of Compliance requirement of Rule 1:20-20 (c) (15) may (1) preclude the Disciplinary Review Board from considering respondent's petition for reinstatement for a period of up to six months from the date respondent files proof of compliance; (2) be found to constitute a violation of RPC 8.1 (b) and RPC 8.4 (c); and (3) provide a basis for an action for contempt pursuant to Rule 1:10-2;


and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17; and it is further

ORDERED that the Order filed July 10, 2018 is vacated, as to the provision that dismissed the motion for reciprocal discipline without prejudice.
