The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 18-326, concluding on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-14(f) (default by respondent) that **Christopher Roy Higgins**, formerly of **Parlin**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2012, should be censured for violating RPC 1.4(b)(failure to keep client reasonably informed about the status of the matter or to comply with reasonable requests for information) and RPC 8.1(b)(failure to cooperate with ethics authorities);
