**ORDER**

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 20-219, concluding that as a matter of final discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-13(c)(2), **Neil I. Mittin**, formerly of **Philadelphia, Pennsylvania**, who was admitted to practice law pro hac vice in this State from 2007 through 2008, should be permanently barred from pro hac vice admission or plenary licensure in New Jersey following respondent's conviction in the United States District Court for the Eastern District of Pennsylvania based on a guilty plea to one count of mail fraud, in violation of 18 U.S.C. §1341;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that respondent's criminal conviction constitutes conduct in violation of RPC 8.4(b) (committing a criminal act that reflects adversely on a lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer in other respects), RPC 8.4 (c) (engaging in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation), and the principles of In re Siegel, 133 N.J. 162 (1993);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Neil I. Mittin** is permanently barred from being licensed to practice law or admitted to practice pro hac vice or in any other manner in New Jersey; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent comply with Rule 1:20-20 dealing with disbarred attorneys; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law admitted to practice in this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
