This matter having been presented to the Court on the recommendation of the Disciplinary Review Board regarding the reinstatement to practice of **Alfred V. Gellene** of **Totowa**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1979 and who has been suspended from the practice of law since April 11, 2022, pursuant to the Order of the Court filed March 11, 2022;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Alfred V. Gellene** be restored to the practice of law, effective immediately; and it is further

ORDERED that **Alfred V. Gellene** participate in treatment by a mental health professional approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics and submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics periodic reports by the mental health professional as

to respondent's treatment and medication plan and respondent's adherence thereto, which schedule of reporting shall be determined by the Office of Attorney Ethics, until the further Order of the Court; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State.
