The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-184, recommending in a matter presented to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-6(c)(1) that Rodrigo Sanchez of Elizabeth, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2001, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(a) (negligently misappropriating entrusted client funds) and RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent (1) complete a recordkeeping course pre-approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days of the Court's order, and (2) provide to the Office of Attorney Ethics monthly three-way reconciliations of respondent's accounts, on a quarterly basis, for a period of two years;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Rodrigo Sanchez** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent complete a recordkeeping course preapproved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days, and provide to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations of respondent's accounts, for a period of two years; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
