The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-241, recommending on the basis of a disciplinary stipulation that **Timothy Joseph McIlwain** of **Northfield**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1996, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(a) (commingling client and personal funds), RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of <u>Rule</u> 1:21-6), and RPC 5.5(a)(1) (engaging in the unauthorized practice of law – failing to maintain liability insurance while practicing law via a limited liability company, as <u>Rule</u> 1:21-1B(a)(4) requires);

And the Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent provide proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics that the account designations on respondent's Fulton Bank attorney business and attorney trust accounts have been corrected, within thirty days of the Court's order;
