This matter having been duly presented pursuant to <u>Rule</u> 1:20-10(b), following a granting of a motion for discipline by consent in DRB 22-218 of **Gregory Joseph Coffey** of **Morristown**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1987;

And the Office of Attorney Ethics and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which the parties agreed that respondent violated RPC 1.3 (lacking diligence), RPC 1.4(b) (failing to keep a client reasonably informed about the status of a matter and to comply with reasonable requests for information), RPC 1.7(a)(1) and (2) (engaging in a concurrent conflict of interest), RPC 8.1(a) (knowingly making a false statement of material fact to disciplinary authorities), and RPC 8.4(c)

(engaging in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation)
(two instances), and that respondent's conduct warrants a reprimand to a
censure or such lesser discipline as the Disciplinary Review Board deems
appropriate;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having determined that respondent violated RPC 1.3, RPC 1.4(b), RPC 1.7(a)(1) and (2), RPC 8.1(a), and RPC 8.4(c) (two instances), and that a censure is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct;

And the Disciplinary Review Board having granted the motion for discipline by consent in District Docket No. XIV-2021-0069E, and having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with <u>Rule</u> 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Gregory Joseph Coffey** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
