**O R D E R**

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 23-180, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **Michael A. Gorokhovich** of **Blackwood**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2004, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6) and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent should be required to (1) complete a recordkeeping course pre-approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days of this order; (2) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, within sixty days of this order, that the recordkeeping deficiencies identified during the audit have been corrected; and (3) provide to the Office of Attorney Ethics monthly reconciliations of respondent's attorney accounts, on a quarterly basis, for two

years;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Michael A. Gorokhovich** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall (1) complete a recordkeeping course pre-approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days; (2) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, within sixty days, that the recordkeeping deficiencies identified during the audit have been corrected; and (3) provide to the Office of Attorney Ethics monthly reconciliations of respondent's attorney accounts, on a quarterly basis, for two years; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
