The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-076, recommending as a matter of final discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-13(c)(2) that Devin Kennedy Kenney of Newton, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2002, should be reprimanded following respondent's guilty plea and convictions in the Superior Court of New Jersey for fourth-degree contempt, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-9(a)(1), two counts of disorderly persons contempt, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:29-9(a)(2), and two counts of petty disorderly persons harassment, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:33-4(a), and for violating RPC 8.4(b) (committing a criminal act that reflects adversely on a lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer in other respects) and RPC 8.4(d) (engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that

respondent be required to report compliance with probation to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, until respondent's probationary term is completed;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Devin Kennedy Kenney** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall report compliance with probation to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, until respondent's probationary term is completed; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
