O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-060, recommending on the basis of a disciplinary stipulation that **Christopher Roy Higgins** of **Milford**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2012, should be disciplined for having violated RPC 5.5(a)(1) (engaging in the unauthorized practice of law); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having evenly split regarding the appropriate quantum of discipline; and

The Court having determined from its review of the matter that a censure is the appropriate quantum of discipline for respondent's unethical conduct;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Christopher Roy Higgins** is hereby censured; and
it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
