This Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its consolidated decision in DRB 24-121, 24-122 and 24-173, recommending on the records certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent), that **Nabil Nadim Kassem**, formerly of **Little Falls**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1994, be disbarred for violating RPC 1.1(a) (engaging in gross neglect) (three instances), RPC 1.3 (lacking diligence) (three instances), RPC 1.4(b) (failing to comply with a client’s reasonable requests for information) (three instances), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (six instances); and

The Court, on November 26, 2024, having disbarred respondent in D-126-23 (089702);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that this matter is dismissed as moot.
