## ORDER

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-154, recommending that **Warren Barry Kahn** of **Sussex**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1983, be disbarred for violating RPC 1.15(a) and the principles of <u>In re Wilson</u>, 81 N.J. 451 (1979), and <u>In re</u> <u>Hollendonner</u>, 102 N.J. 21 (1985) (knowingly misappropriating escrow funds), RPC 4.1(a)(1) (making a false statement of material fact to a third person), RPC 8.4(c) (engaging in conduct involving dishonesty, fraud, deceit, or misrepresentation) (two instances), and RPC 8.4(d) (engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice); and

The Court, on January 14, 2025, having ordered respondent to show cause before this Court, on March 31, 2025, why respondent should not be disbarred or otherwise disciplined; and

Respondent thereafter having tendered consent to disbarment; and

The Court this date having disbarred **Warren Barry Kahn** by consent (D-62-24);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that the Order to Show Cause filed on January 14, 2025, is hereby vacated and this matter (D-51-24) (DRB 24-154) is dismissed as moot.
