O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-120, recommending on the basis of a disciplinary stipulation that **John Stephen Lubenesky of Montclair**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2000, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(b) (failing to promptly deliver funds to a client), RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to (1) demonstrate to the Office of Attorney Ethics that respondent has corrected the outstanding recordkeeping deficiencies within thirty days of the Court's order and (2) complete a recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days of the Court's

order and submit proof thereof within fifteen days of completing the course;

And good cause appearing;


It is ORDERED that **John Stephen Lubenesky** is hereby reprimanded;
and it is further

ORDERED that respondent (1) shall submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics that respondent has corrected the outstanding recordkeeping deficiencies, within thirty days and (2) shall complete a recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days and submit proof thereof within fifteen days of completing the course; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
