The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-143, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **Jay Lowell Juckett**, formerly of **Allenhurst**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1987, and who has been temporarily suspended from the practice of law since January 29, 2024, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6) and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (two instances); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to fully cooperate with the Office of Attorney Ethics' investigation in Docket No. XIV-2023-0231E;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that Jay Lowell Juckett is hereby reprimanded; and it

is further

ORDERED that respondent shall remain suspended from the practice of law pursuant to the order filed on January 29, 2024, and shall cooperate with Office of Attorney Ethics' investigation as a precondition for reinstatement under <u>Rule</u> 1:20-11(e); and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
