CORRECTED ORDER

(Attorney No. 259822019) :

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-172, recommending as a matter of final discipline pursuant to Rule 1:20-13(c)(2) that **Robert William Evans** of **Lakewood**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2019, should be suspended for a period of three months, following respondent's guilty plea in the Superior Court of New Jersey, and admission to the pretrial intervention (PTI) program for a term of eighteen months, for third-degree aggravated assault, in violation of N.J.S.A. 2C:12-1(b)(12), and for violating RPC 8.4(b) (committing a criminal act that reflects adversely on a lawyer's honesty, trustworthiness, or fitness as a lawyer in other respects); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that the three-month suspension be suspended, conditioned on respondent's compliance with PTI; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to report to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, respondent's compliance with PTI until PTI is completed, and that if respondent fails to comply with PTI, upon submission to the Court of a detailed certification by the Office of Attorney Ethics reporting respondent's failure to comply with PTI, respondent shall be suspended for three months, without further notice;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Robert William Evans** is suspended from the practice of law for a period of three months, and that the term of suspension is suspended as set forth below; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall comply with PTI and report to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, respondent's compliance with PTI until PTI is completed; and it is further

ORDERED that if respondent fails to comply with PTI, upon submission to the Court of a detailed certification by the Office of Attorney Ethics reporting respondent's failure to comply with PTI, respondent shall be suspended for three months, without further notice; and it is further

ORDERED that if respondent successfully completes PTI then respondent will not have to serve the suspension; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
