The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-227, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **Ivan Raevski** of **Metuchen**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2007, should be censured for violating RPC 1.1(a) (engaging in gross neglect), RPC 1.3 (lacking diligence), RPC 1.4(b) (failing to keep a client reasonably informed about the status of a matter and to promptly comply with reasonable requests for information), RPC 1.4(c) (failing to explain a matter to the extent reasonably necessary to permit a client to make informed decisions regarding the representation), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (two instances); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to disgorge \$2,350 to his former clients;


And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Ivan Raevski** is hereby censured; and it is further ORDERED that respondent shall disgorge \$2,350 to his former clients within thirty days; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
