The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-292, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(j) (default by respondent) that **Kenneth James Rosellini**, formerly of **Clifton**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1998, and who has been temporarily suspended from the practice of law since November 16, 2023, should be suspended for a period of three months for violating RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (two instances), and RPC 8.4(d) (engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to provide proof that respondent satisfied the outstanding sanctions awards within forty-five days;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Kenneth James Rosellini** is hereby censured; and
it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall provide proof to the Office of Attorney
Ethics, within forty-five days, that respondent satisfied the sanctions orders as
directed in the Court's May 16, 2023 order; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent
part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight
Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in
the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
