The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to complete a continuing legal education course on office management approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days of the Court's order;

It is ORDERED that **Joseph Ricigliano**, **Jr.** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall complete a continuing legal education course on office management approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in
the prosecution of this matter, as provided in <u>Rule</u> 1:20-17.
