The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 24-300, recommending in a matter presented to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-6(c)(1) that Daniel J. McCracken of Audubon, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2011, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.5(c) (failing to provide an accounting at the conclusion of a contingent fee matter), RPC 1.15(a) (failing to safeguard funds and negligently misappropriating entrusted funds) (two instances), RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6), and RPC 5.3(a) and (b) (failing to supervise nonlawyer staff); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, within sixty days of the Court's order, that he has either disbursed \$8,551.24 to Estate Information Services, LLC (EIS) or, if respondent is unable to locate EIS or its

successor or assigns after a diligent search, remitted \$8,551.24 to the Superior Court Trust Fund;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Daniel J. McCracken** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that as respondent shall submit proof to the Office of
Attorney Ethics within sixty days that respondent either disbursed \$8,551.24 to
Estate Information Services, LLC (EIS) or, if respondent is unable to locate
EIS or its successors or assigns after a diligent search, remitted \$8,551.24 to
the Superior Court Trust Fund; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight

Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in

the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
