O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-079, recommending on the basis of a disciplinary stipulation that **Gary P. Lightman of Plymouth Meeting, Pennsylvania**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1979, should be censured for violating RPC 3.1 (engaging in frivolous litigation), RPC 3.2 (failing to treat all persons involved in the litigation process with courtesy and consideration), RPC 3.4(d) (making frivolous discovery requests), RPC 3.4(g) (threatening opposing counsel with criminal charges to gain an improper advantage in a civil matter), RPC 4.4(a) (engaging in conduct that has no substantial purpose other than to embarrass, delay, or burden a third party), and RPC 8.4(d) (engaging in conduct prejudicial to the administration of justice); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to complete a continuing education course in legal

ethics and professionalism approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days of the Court's order;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Gary P. Lightman** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall complete a continuing education course in legal ethics and professionalism approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics within sixty days; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
