**O R D E R**

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-152, recommending in a matter presented to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-6(c)(1) that **Tamara Laniece Sharp of Cherry Hill**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2016, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6), RPC 5.5(a)(1) (engaging in the unauthorized practice of law by failing to maintain professional liability insurance while practicing as a limited liability company, as required by Rule 1:21-1B(a)(4)), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, within ninety days of the Court's order, that respondent has (1) attended a

recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, (2) cured the outstanding deficiencies identified during the Office of Attorney Ethics' investigation, and (3) obtained professional liability insurance; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations, for a period of two years;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Tamara Laniece Sharp** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, within ninety days, that respondent has: (1) attended a recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, (2) cured all outstanding deficiencies identified by the Office of Attorney Ethics, and (3) obtained professional liability insurance; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations, for two years; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
