O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-179, recommending in a matter presented to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-6(c)(1) that **Brian P. Largey** of **Middletown**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2009, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6) and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required, within sixty days of the Court's order, to (1) attend a recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, and (2) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics of respondent's fitness to practice law as attested to by a medical doctor approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, with a description of respondent's progress; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations, for a period of two years ;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Brian P. Largey** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall, within sixty days: (1) attend a recordkeeping course approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, and (2) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics of respondent's fitness to practice law, as attested to by a medical doctor approved by the Office Attorney Ethics, with a description of respondent's progress; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations, for two years; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
