O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-162, recommending that **David R. Cardamone** of **Shrewsbury**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2010, should be disciplined for having violated RPC 1.2(d) (assisting a client in conduct that the lawyer knows is illegal, criminal, or fraudulent), RPC 1.4(d) (failing to advise a client of the limitations on the lawyer’s conduct, when the client expects assistance not permitted by the RPCs), RPC 1.15(a) (failing to safeguard funds in which a third party has an interest), and RPC 1.15(b) (failing to deliver to the client any funds or other property the client is entitled to receive); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having evenly split regarding the appropriate quantum of discipline; and

The Court having determined from its review of the matter that a censure

is the appropriate quantum of discipline;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **David R. Cardamone** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
