**O R D E R**

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-192, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **Michael C. Mone**, formerly of **Flemington**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1965, and who has been temporarily suspended from the practice of law since January 15, 2025, should be censured for violating RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6) and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (two instances); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to (1) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics, that respondent has cured the outstanding deficiencies identified during the Office of Attorney Ethics' investigation, within ninety days of the Court's order, and (2) submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations for a period of two years;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Michael C. Mone** is hereby censured; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall (1) submit proof to the Office of Attorney Ethics that respondent has cured the outstanding deficiencies identified during the Office of Attorney Ethics' investigation, within ninety days, and (2) submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations for a period of two years; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall remain suspended from the practice of law pursuant to the order filed on January 15, 2025; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
