The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-260, recommending that **Emmanuel Coffy** of **Maplewood**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2006, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 3.1 (engaging in frivolous litigation) and RPC 5.5(a)(1) (engaging in the unauthorized practice of law – practicing law while administratively ineligible); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to take steps to seal and remove the settlement agreement from the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board’s public docket, within thirty days of the Court’s order;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Emmanuel Coffy** is hereby reprimanded; and it is

further

ORDERED that respondent shall take steps to seal and remove the settlement agreement from the Trademark Trial and Appeal Board's public docket, within thirty days; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
