O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board having filed with the Court its decision in DRB 25-270, recommending on the record certified to the Board pursuant to Rule 1:20-4(f) (default by respondent) that **Jaclyn Nayar of South Orange**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2012, should be reprimanded for violating RPC 1.3 (lacking diligence), RPC 1.4(b) (failing to keep a client reasonably informed about the status of a matter and failing to promptly comply with reasonable requests for information), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities) (two instances); and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics proof of respondent's fitness to practice law, as attested to by a medical doctor approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, within sixty days of the Court's

order;

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Jaclyn Nayar** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics proof of respondent's fitness to practice law, as attested to by a medical doctor approved by the Office of Attorney Ethics, within sixty days; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
