O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board, in DRB 26-096, having granted a motion for discipline by consent, pursuant to Rule 1:20-10(b), of **Zaniah D. Maynor of Edison**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 2020; and

The Office of Attorney Ethics and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which the parties agreed that respondent violated RPC 1.15(d) (failing to comply with the recordkeeping requirements of Rule 1:21-6), RPC 5.5(a)(1) (practicing law as a limited liability company without an insurance certificate on file with the Clerk of the Supreme Court as required by Rule 1:21-1B(b)), and RPC 8.1(b) (failing to cooperate with disciplinary authorities), and that respondent's conduct warrants a reprimand or such lesser discipline as the Disciplinary Review Board deems appropriate; and

The Office of Attorney Ethics and respondent having further agreed that respondent should be required to (1) attend a course in trust and business accounting offered by the Office of Attorney Ethics within six months of the final order of discipline and provide proof of completion to the Office of Attorney Ethics within fifteen days, and (2) submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations for a period of two years following the final order of discipline; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having determined that respondent violated RPC 1.15(d), RPC 5.5(a)(1), and RPC 8.1(b), and that a reprimand is the appropriate discipline for respondent's unethical conduct; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having further recommended that respondent be required to (1) attend a course in trust and business accounting offered by the Office of Attorney Ethics within six months of the Court's order, and (2) submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations for a period of two years; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with Rule 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Zaniah D. Maynor** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent shall (1) attend a course in trust and business accounting offered by the Office of Attorney Ethics within six months, and (2) submit to the Office of Attorney Ethics, on a quarterly basis, monthly three-way reconciliations for two years; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
