O R D E R

The Disciplinary Review Board, in DRB 26-151, having granted a motion for discipline by consent, pursuant to Rule 1:20-10(b), of **Harry Furman of Vineland**, who was admitted to the bar of this State in 1985; and

The District I Ethics Committee and respondent having signed a stipulation of discipline by consent in which the parties agreed that respondent violated RPC 1.3 (lacking diligence) and RPC 1.4(b) (failing to keep a client reasonably informed about the status of a matter and to promptly comply with reasonable requests for information), and that respondent's conduct warrants a reprimand or such lesser discipline as the Disciplinary Review Board deems appropriate; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having determined that respondent violated RPC 1.3 and RPC 1.4(b), and that a reprimand is the appropriate

discipline for respondent's unethical conduct; and

The Disciplinary Review Board having submitted the record of the proceedings to the Clerk of the Supreme Court for the entry of an order of discipline in accordance with Rule 1:20-16(e);

And good cause appearing;

It is ORDERED that **Harry Furman** is hereby reprimanded; and it is further

ORDERED that the entire record of this matter be made a permanent part of respondent's file as an attorney at law of this State; and it is further

ORDERED that respondent reimburse the Disciplinary Oversight Committee for appropriate administrative costs and actual expenses incurred in the prosecution of this matter, as provided in Rule 1:20-17.
